Security needs all of us!</b>	<b>8</b>  Be your brother's keeper. Don't let others work unsafe!

<b>16</b>  <b>NEVER walk on empty pallets or across equipment forks.</b>	<b>17</b>  Safety is looking out for your coworkers as well as yourself!	<b>18</b>  <i>Wear your PPE at all times! It's for your protection.</i>	<b>19</b>  <b>Security is safety too. Don't let strangers walk around unidentified!</b>	<b>20</b>  Don't overreach! Avoid the strain by asking for help.	<b>21</b>  Always look in the direction of travel!	<b>22</b>  <b>Remember to keep electrical panels clear by at least 3 feet.</b>
